

General statement on products and materials, JORVIK Group workshops, completed 23rd August 2018

Our workshops use authentic materials to bring history to life.

It is unlikely in most cases that you will come into direct contact with any of these materials, but please contact our education department if you have any specific concerns.

All of these materials are used as props in our workshops, **not as foodstuffs**.

- Plant materials: fruit stones, cereal grains, seeds. Dried raisins, legumes, liquorice, cinnamon, cloves, nutmeg. Fresh mint, bay, lavender, comfrey. Flour.
- Animal products: fur (various), goose feathers, dried fish, oyster shell, cuttlefish bone, wool.
